



Thierry Fischer Conductor



Swiss conductor Thierry Fischer has been Music Director of the Utah Symphony since 2009, recently extended to 2022. In April 2016 he took the orchestra to Carnegie Hall for the first time in 40 years, has instigated a major commissioning programme, and has recorded CDs of contemporary repertoire and Mahler symphonies. Last season he appeared at Mostly Mozart New York and Maggio Musicale Firenze, toured with the Chamber Orchestra of Europe, and conducted the London Philharmonic in concert and on CD. Recent guesting has also included the Boston Symphony, Oslo Philharmonic and Rotterdam Philharmonic. Whilst Principal Conductor of BBC National Orchestra of Wales 2016-2012 he appeared annually at the BBC Proms and toured to Europe and China, also making many CDs, notably for Hyperion. He was Principal Conductor and Artistic Advisor of the Ulster Orchestra 2001-2006 and Chief Conductor of the Nagoya Philharmonic 2008-2011, now Honorary Guest Conductor. He begins as Principal Guest Conductor of the Seoul Philharmonic in January 2017, running concurrently with his position in Utah.
