

## Antony Hermus Conductor



Dutch conductor Antony Hermus is Principal Guest of the North Netherlands Orchestra, Artistic Advisor of the National Youth Orchestra of the Netherlands and has recently been appointed Principle Guest Conductor of Opera North. He studied piano and conducting at the Tilburg Conservatory, becoming Music Director of the Theatre Hagen at the age of 29. From 2009 to 2015 he was Music Director of the Anhaltisches Theater in Dessau, where he conducted his first Ring cycle and was nominated for Conductor of the Year in Opernwelt magazine for three years in a row. He has an extensive repertoire and has guested in many houses including Stuttgart, Komische Oper Berlin, Gothenburg, Strasbourg, Opera de Rouen and Dutch Reisopera, all of whom have reinvited. He has a flourishing symphonic career also, conducting amongst others the Rotterdam Philharmonic, Netherlands Radio Philharmonic, Bamberg Symphony, MDR Leipzig Symphony, Melbourne Symphony, Seoul Philharmonic, Orchestre de la Suisse Romande, and Danish Radio Symphony. In the UK he has conducted the BBC Philharmonic and the BBC Scottish Symphony, and made his Royal Philharmonic debut in Spring 2019. He made his UK operatic debut with Opera North in Autumn 2018.
