



Thierry Fischer Conductor



Swiss conductor Thierry Fischer has been Music Director of the Utah Symphony since 2009, recently extended to 2022. In April 2016 he took the orchestra to Carnegie Hall for the first time in 40 years, has instigated a major commissioning programme, and has recorded CDs of contemporary repertoire and Mahler symphonies. Recent guesting has included the Boston Symphony, London Philharmonic and Chamber Orchestra of Europe. Whilst Principal Conductor of BBC National Orchestra of Wales 2016-2012 he appeared annually at the BBC Proms and toured to Europe and China, also making many CDs, notably for Hyperion. He was Principal Conductor and Artistic Advisor of the Ulster Orchestra 2001-2006 and Chief Conductor of the Nagoya Philharmonic 2008-2011, now Honorary Guest Conductor. He has been Principal Guest Conductor of the Seoul Philharmonic since January 2017.
